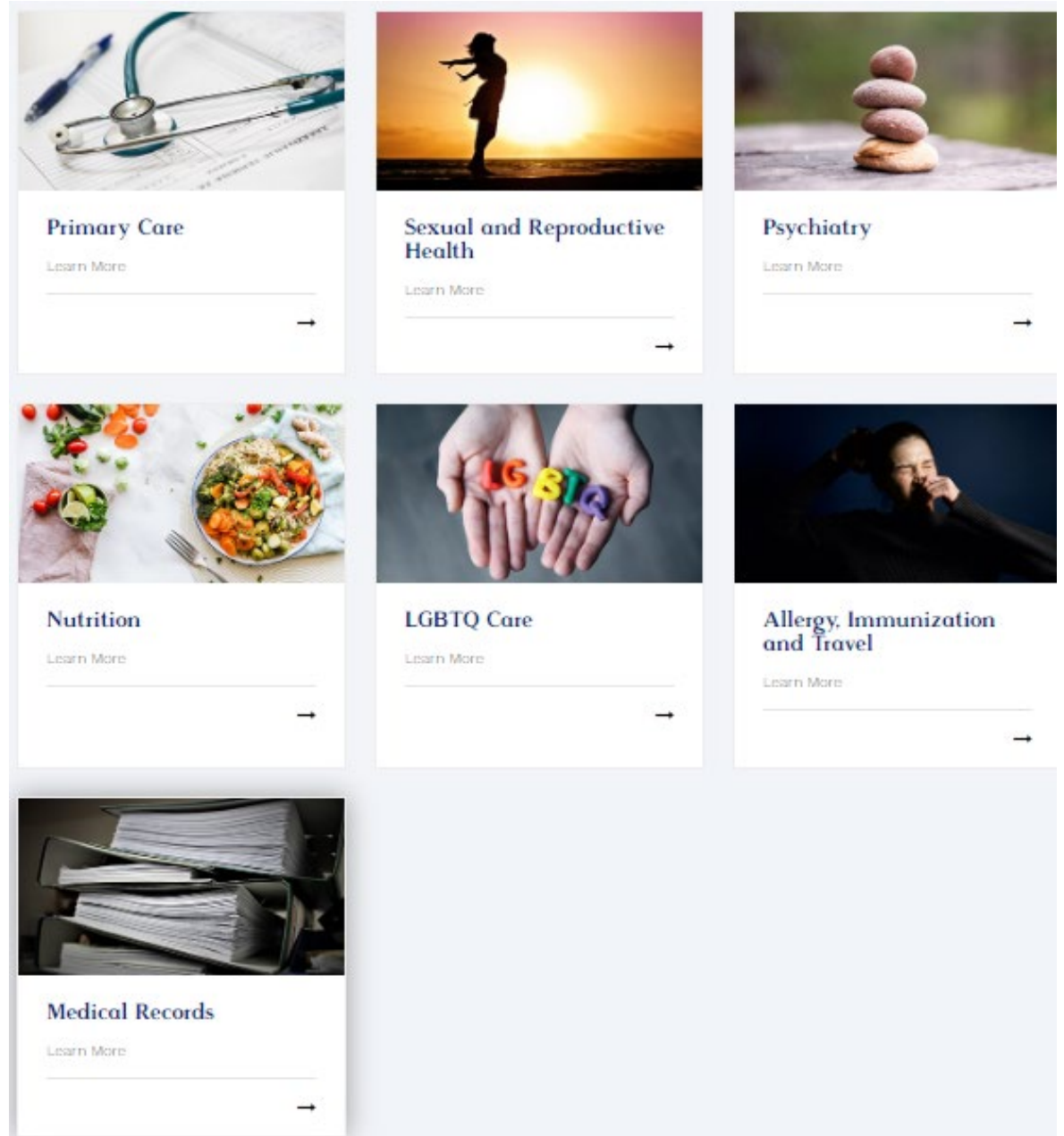

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- Students are required **BY THE UNIVERSITY** to be compliant with the Emory University Immunization Requirements as guided by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the American College Health Association (ACHA).
- These requirements will be part of the onboarding requirements to safely arrive on campus.

# Required Immunizations

- ✓ MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)- 2 doses
- ✓ Varicella (chicken pox)- 2 doses
- ✓ Hepatitis B-complete series (2 or 3 doses)
- ✓ Tetanus-Diphtheria Pertussis (Whooping Cough)
- ✓ Meningococcal Vaccine ACWY (if living on campus)

- ✓ Polio
- ✓ Hepatitis A

**Note: A Physical Exam is a requirement for all Allied Health, Medical, and Nursing students but not a requirement for students in any other school.**

All Allied Health, Medical and Nursing students are required to have a physical examination. You can find the examination form under "Forms" on the left side menu. Please enter the date your physical exam was completed in the date field below.

If you have a temporary condition and will be receiving the COVID-19 vaccine in the future, use the [Student Temporary Medical Deferral Form](#) which must also be signed by a healthcare provider and upload below. Your letter will be reviewed within 5 days and you will receive a communication from our Immunization Compliance team via the Patient Portal.

Students who have a strongly held religious belief objection preventing them from receiving the COVID-19 vaccine may download a [Student Religious Exemption Form](#) and submit it on the [Return to Campus Dashboard](#) for review by a multidisciplinary University Committee.
